

Violinist, educator, and producer Barbora Valiukevičiūtė is praised internationally for her energetic, charismatic stage appearance, captivating interpretations, and magical sonorous tone. Barbora is the founder of the Baltic duet. Ensemble repertoire focuses on performing and promoting Baltic sea region music. In addition, Barbora is the creator of the online Music Academy for Young Professionals (MAFYP). In 2021 she became a cultural ambassador for the Kaunas European Capital of Culture 2022.

She has performed at world-renowned venues such as Metropolitan Museum Concert Hall, Veronica Hagman Concert Hall, Staller Center for the Arts in the US, Auditorium al Duomo in Italy, Fukuoka Across Hall in Japan, and the National Philharmonic of Lithuania.

Ms. Valiukeviciute was born in Kaunas, Lithuania, into a family of art aesthetes. After studying violin at Juozas Naujalis Music, she pursued her music education in Italy under Pavel Vernikov. Later on, she moved to the USA and continued violin performance studies with renowned violinists such as Grigory Kalinovsky at Manhattan School of Music, Philip Setzer at Stony Brook University, and Ilya Kaler DePaul University.
